Equations and their Solutions

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VOCABULARY

- Equation: a mathematical statement that show two expressions are equal Solution: the value or values that make an equation true
- <u>Inverse operations</u>: operations that undo each other ex. Addition/subtraction, multiplication/division
- <u>linear equation</u>: an equation whose solution forms a straight line on a coordinate grid

Adding Equations Steps

- **Step 1**: Isolate the variable (put it by itself).
- Step 2: Use inverse operations to undo the equation.
- **Step 3**: Solve the equation.

```
Example: x + 87 = 152
-87 -87
x = 65
```

Determining Solutions of Equations

Adding Equations

Example: a + 23 = 82 -23 -23 a = 59

Another Example

Example: 15 + x = 57 -15 -15 x = 42

Subtraction Equations
