## ADD AND SUBTRACT

## Steps are the same:

1. Line up the decimal places:

| 1.334 | 4.556 | $*$ for subtraction make sure <br> the largest number is on top |
| ---: | ---: | ---: |
| +3.09 | -2.09 |  |

2. Add or subtract!

## What if there isn't a number to subtract from?

- Example: 8.9 - 7.52 =

$$
\begin{aligned}
& 8.90 \text { *add a zero } \\
& -\quad 7.52
\end{aligned}
$$

_- Then regroup with the 9 to make the zero a 10 !

- What's the answer?
